

The purpose of the Sister City relationship is to promote cultural awareness, economic development, and tourism. McArthur Island Park is bustling with activity, boasting ball diamonds, soccer fields, tennis courts, disc golf, bike paths, an inclusive playground and a skate park, not to mention the Sport & Event Centre. The gardens and natural landscapes on the island attract a wealth of wildlife happily co-existing with our outdoor sport enthusiasts.



Each spring, while quantities last, the City opens the Tree Coupon program with an aim to support the City's goal of increasing our community's tree canopy to 20% from the current 15%, as identified in the Urban Forestry Management Strategy. The coupons allow residents a \$20 or \$50 discount, depending on the price of the tree.

This award-winning park includes ball diamonds, playground, pond, and a community centre. There is also a water park, washrooms, change rooms, and a fresh water fountain available.



The City of Kamloops has several cemeteries that it owns and operates, including two active use cemeteries (Hillside Cemetery and Pleasant Street Cemetery), as well as three historic cemeteries (Chinese Cemetery, Pioneer Cemetery, Old Men's Provincial Cemetery). Recently, the Mountain Vista Mausoleum was built to accommodate a growing need for burial options.





### **Help Us Serve You Better**



Place containers at the curb by 7:00 am on collection day.



During Bear Smart season (Apr 1–Nov 30), set containers out after 4:00 am and properly manage bear attractants (Bylaw No. 40-67).



Container lids must be completely closed for pickup.



Break boxes into newspaper-sized pieces so they can fall loosely from containers into collection trucks.



Containers must be kept clean.



Secure all containers on private property on non-collection days.



Place containers in a safe location for collection, away from overhead obstacles (trees, basketball hoops, balconies), fences, and parked vehicles.



In the winter, place containers on the road side of snow piles and windrows.



Help improve collection efficiency. Set garbage and recycling containers out for collection when they are at least half full.



Place organics cart out every collection day, no matter the amount of material.

### Moving?

Containers are registered with the property address, so please do not take containers with you when you move. Container change requests can only be made by registered homeowners by calling 250-828-3461.

### **2025 SOLID WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

#### **Dual Pass Collection**

The City began a dual pass system in 2023. In dual pass collection, one truck collects one type of material and a second truck collects a different type of material, as opposed to a single truck collecting two types of material separated with a divider.

Your organics and recycling or garbage will be collected on the same day (see your zone's collection schedule), but they may be collected at different times.

#### Waste may not be collected if:


- material is not contained and the lid is not closed
- · carts are inaccessible or spaced improperly
- · carts contain unaccepted material



Carts MUST be placed out by 7:00 am on collection day. Operators will not return to pick up carts not placed at the curb on time.



The Rivers Trail is a network of 40km of trails connecting Kamloops' downtown and North Shore along the North and South Thompson Rivers. Frequented by walkers, runners, cyclists, roller bladers, four-legged friends, and the like, the Rivers Trail network is mostly flat with both paved and unpaved sections of trail. The paved sections are accessible year-round as the City of Kamloops maintains and clears the snow during winter months.

The Kamloops Bike Ranch is a 26-hectare park located in Juniper Ridge and includes a diverse set of trails for beginners to pro level riders, stadium lights, a jump park, skills area, and the newly added all-wheels pump track facility, made possible by community partners and the Province of BC's Destination Development Fund.



As Canada's Tournament Capital, our parks and sports fields are home to a wide array of City-led and City-sponsored events and tournaments throughout the year, whether it be a slo-pitch tournament at McArthur Island Park or a soccer championship at Hillside Stadium. In 2024, our Parks crews readied our fields to accommodate a total of 136 tournaments, which is an increase from 2023, and a number we are expected to surpass in 2025.

McDonald Park is a community hub on the North Shore. The park features a small bandshell and has been home to the Tapestry Festival as well as its own limited 'Music in the Park' showcases. There is a seasonal water park for the kids, washrooms, and a fresh water fountain.



With nine dog parks available for your use across the city, there is no lack of opportunity to take Fido for some exercise. A reminder that dogs are not permitted near playgrounds, picnic areas, wading pools, water parks, schoolyards, or playing fields.

Peterson Creek Park is a great family hiking and picnicing area located just off Columbia Street, near 6th Avenue. There are plenty of grassy areas, picnic tables, and scenic hiking trails. The park is adjacent to a 1.7-kilometre paved multi-use path called the Xget'tem' Trail ("deep valley" in Secwepemctsín). It connects pedestrians and cyclists from Sahali to downtown.
