
- Offset or trim 3–4 sheets of paper to create a square.
- Pold point B to point A.
- You now have a triangle shape.









- Bring point C of the triangle to point AB.
- Now bring point B over to meet point AC.
- You now have a pentagon shape.








- Split apart the top flap (point A) and fold down both sides.
- You now have a paper pouch!







Spread apart sides of paper pouch and place into your organics bin.
